Blue Mountains City Council is calling for expressions of interest for a new member to join the volunteer Braemar Gallery Management Committee. Braemar Gallery is located within the heritage property, Braemar House, on Macquarie Road, Springwood, and is part of the Blue Mountains Theatre and Community Hub arts precinct. It is a community, volunteer run, non-commercial gallery presenting exhibitions that showcase works of local and regional artists.

The Management Committee is a volunteer advisory responsible for mounting and marketing exhibitions, collaborating with artists, supporting volunteers and engaging visitors.

The Committee is seeking a Community Engagement & Events Coordinator for a two-year term. If you are passionate about the visual arts and interested in supporting Braemar Gallery with community partnerships, volunteer events and activities, we welcome your expression of interest. The role works in collaboration with the Volunteer Coordinator and Council Staff Administrator.

Key responsibilities include:

- Oversee exhibition openings and ensure Committee member roster and event check-list in order;
- Work with community groups to generate awareness of Braemar Gallery;
- Develop events and communications to attract new volunteers;
- Work with the Volunteer Coordinator to support, engage and acknowledge volunteers;
- Organise and promote regular volunteer events.

Community Engagement & Events Coordinator Criteria

- Experience working with community groups and volunteers;
- Experience organising events'
- Experience preparing marketing information; and
- Flexibility and availability to attend and host events.

General Committee Member Criteria

- Availability to attend a Management Committee meeting on the afternoon of the second Thursday of each month;
- Availability to complete one three-hour monthly volunteer shift;
- Experience or interest in visual arts and liaising with artists;
- Commitment to volunteering with a not-for-profit organisation; and
- Follow Council and Committee policies and procedures.
