The ever-popular Sport for Jove return to the Blue Mountains with seasons at Everglades Gardens and Blue Mountains Theatre.

Welcome to Ephesus – the great hustling, bustling (with the emphasis on hustling!) metropolis of Europe – the perfect place to lose yourself. Utterly.

Sport for Jove's modern, razor-sharp take on *The Comedy of Errors* shatters Shakespeare's mistaken identity farce wide open - exposing the ache of dislocation, the absurdity of city living, and the miracle of rediscovery and reconciliation.
