Stomping Ground: Rummage & Roam will present a vibrant pre-loved clothing and vintage fashion market with creative, eco-friendly workshops and local maker stalls offering a range of unique, sustainable handmade items. A community picnic in the Hub forecourt will bring the entire community together with family entertainment including live music and dance performances. Picnic boxes will be available to pre-order. To celebrate the public art of Springwood town centre, a Street Art Tour will lead visitors to a new public art installation at the School of Arts Square with a lively program of local singer/songwriters, and artist-led workshops and artist talks will be offered as part of a new, community-inspired mural to be launched on the day. *Reconnect in spaces we love - rummage and roam through Springwood Town Centre!*

Applications to be a stallholder are now open! Clear out your wardrobe, make some cash, and recycle your preloved designer and vintage clothing and/or accessories.

- Stalls are available for sellers from the general public, not regular market sellers.
- Stallholders will be invited to be swap/sell one hour before opening to the public on the day. The market will open to the public from 10 am to 3pm.
- There will be a range of long length mirrors available
- Help will be available on the day for setting up and merchandising stalls
- All stalls will be inside
- Stall space is 2 m²
- Roaming stylists will be available on the day
- The stall cost is **\$65**

Allocation of sites

The Stomping Ground team will review applications and select stallholders to ensure our shoppers are offered the highest quality and most spectacular range of second-hand, preloved designer and vintage fashion and accessories. The Stomping Ground team will curate stalls to suit a variety of styles, sizes and budgets.

Applications to be a stallholder will close **Friday, 19 August 2022**. Successful applicants will be notified **Friday, 27 August 2022**. A maximum of 25 stalls will be available. When capacity is reached, we will open a waiting list application.

We will respond to all applicants by email. If your application is successful, you will be asked to confirm your booking by paying via Square/card or bank deposit within 5 days. After that time, if payment is not received, your stall will be reallocated to someone on the wait list.

Clothes and/or accessories should be:

- Preferably high end, good quality, and/or preloved designer labels, not fast fashion labels
- Unique and/or vintage items in excellent condition
- Clean and pressed - no soiled, stained or damaged items
- Labelled with price tag

Stalls and stallholders:

- Minimum of 25 items per stall
- Must be available to be fully set up before 8.30am on the day
- Provide your own table (no longer than 1.5 m) and tablecloth/cover
- Provide your own clothes rack, hangers, baskets, etc
- Maximum of two people working at each stall
- Provide own cash float and/or eftpos square (Ideally) to limit cash handling.
- Provide own table mirror for use with accessories, etc
- Must be packed up and venue vacated by 4.30pm, but stalls cannot be packed up earlier than 3 pm.

A detailed information guide will be emailed to our stallholders two weeks before the market. The guide will clarify set up and access on the day, as well as tips and ideas for creating a unique stall and memorable day.

No onsite ATM or WIFI access*

Please note there is no onsite ATM access for market patrons. An ATM is located at the hotel next door, and bank ATMs are located a short stroll away on Macquarie Road.

WIFI access is available inside the building, however If you require internet access for your point of sale, we recommend you be prepared to use your mobile phone for hotspot internet.

Parking

Free onsite parking is available at the rear of the facility (access via David Road).
