Renowned for his electrifying live shows, Ash Grunwald has inspired a generation to hit the road in an old van to "surf by day, jam by night".




Abandoned Cricket Games is Jerrah's third full-length album and it traverses detailed and vivid themes. Noted for his whimsical style and beautiful harmonies from previous albums, both of which were launched at the Blue Mountains Theatre to rapturous reception; Jerrah works with his songwriting collaborator Sam Worrad at Club Weld, a studio for neurodivergent musicians located at ACE in Parramatta.

Braemar Gallery

Braemar House is part of the Blue Mountains Theatre and Community Hub precinct. It is home to Braemar Gallery and a planned creative co-working space.

Opened in 1988, Braemar Gallery is a community non-commercial gallery, hosting changing exhibitions each month that showcase works of local and regional artists. The gallery presents an annual program of exhibitions from local artists coordinated by a Management Committee and run by a team of volunteers.

Hub Upstairs Gallery

Opened in 2023, the Hub Upstairs Gallery is a new display space in Springwood, showcasing our vibrant arts community with regularly changing exhibitions from Blue Mountains visual artists.

Located on Level 1 of the Blue Mountains Theatre and Community Hub, the gallery is open 9am to 6 pm weekdays, 10 am to 4 pm weekends and when the theatre is open for events outside of these hours.

Love Local Makers Market

The Love Local Makers Market is an artisan crafts market held on the forecourt of Blue Mountains Theatre & Community Hub.

This curated market brings together a range of contemporary local artists and producers, with all goods crafted by hand in the Blue Mountains.
